William Ball & Daniel Ball - Be it remembered that the Plaintiff filed the following as a cause of action against said Defendants to wit; see cause on file in my office and on the 4th day of March 1848 a summons and subpoena was served directed to B. F. Gorsline Constable of West Township made returnable on the 11th day of March 1848 at one O'clock P.M. on said day

the above case continued till the 15th day of March 1848 at at 10 O'clock A.M. By agreement of the parties and now to wit on the 15th day of March 1848 comes the parties by their attorneys the case being called one of the Defendants Daniel Ball moves the Court for a nonsuit on the grounds of his not being one of the party in this suit, which motion was not sustained the parties goes into trial and the cause & proceedings & all things touching the same being fully heard & inspected, the said Justice take till the 18th of said Month for a full Decision. It is therefore considered that said Plaintiff recover of said Defendants the sum of thirteen Dollars & forty six cents for his Debt & Damages with Interest thereon at the rate of six percent per annum till paid from the date of this Judgment with cost of suit taxed at five Dollars & seven teen cents

of the County of Adams, are held and firmly
bound unto Ziba Dorwin in the penal sum of
Fifty dollars, for the payment whereof, well and
truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves,
our heirs, and assigns, jointly and severally,
firmly by these presents, Sealed with our
Seals and dated this 10th, ~~April~~ April A D 1848.

The Condition of the above obligation is
such, that whereas the above bound Daniel
Ball and William Ball have this day ap-
pealed to the Adams Circuit Court, from the
Judgement of Zedekiah Brown Esq. a Justice of
the Peace of said County, lately rendered in
favour of the said Ziba Dorwin against them
the said Daniel & William Ball;

Now if the said Daniel Ball and
William Ball will prosecute their said appeal
with effect, and without unnecessary delay and
pay the full amount of condemnation and costs,
which may be adjudged or awarded against
them in the said Circuit Court, then the above
obligation is to be void, otherwise to remain in
full force.
