BE IT KNOWN, that, on the ^{two} ~~one~~ ~~thirty~~ day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty ~~one~~, I, M. W. HUBBELL, a NOTARY PUBLIC, in and for the said County of Allen, by authority of law, duly appointed and qualified, at the request of the PRESIDENT AND DIRECTORS of the BRANCH AT FORT WAYNE, OF THE STATE BANK OF INDIANA, holder of the original Note, a copy of which is above written, after the close of the usual bank hours, did exhibit the same at the said BRANCH BANK (where it is made payable,) for payment, and demanded payment thereof, of the CASHIER of said BRANCH BANK, and received for answer,—“That there were no funds there provided for the payment of the same; and that it would not be paid.”—Wherefore, I then protested the said NOTE for non-payment, and notified the endorser.
