lenged lands & tenments if default be made in the condition following
which condition is that the said James Wilson shall personally be and
appear before the judges of the Adams Circuit Court on the first day
of the next Term thereof to be helden at the Court House in the Town of
Decatur in said County of Adams on the second day of November next
to answer unto the said State of Indiana in an Indictment for suffering
gaining in his Tavern & abide the judgment of said Court thereon and
not depart therefrom without leave of said Court.
