Jacob North plaintiff  
in this action complains of Emanuel  
Woods and Daniel Railings defendants  
and says that in the month of January  
1868 the plaintiff and the defendants entered  
into Copartnership for the purpose and  
with a view of carrying on the business  
of buying ~~shaving~~ and selling horses  
that by the terms conditions and agreements  
of said Copartnership as agreed upon between  
the plaintiff and defendants each of said  
parties was to find and furnish for the  
use of the Copartnership one third of the  
money that said Copartnership might  
from time to time invest in said business  
and that each of said partners was to  
have one third of the profits of said business  
that would be realized therefrom and  
that each of said partners should bear  
one third of the loss that might be sustained  
in the carrying on of said Copartnership  
business, in short the said plaintiff and  
defendants were to be equal partners in

all things relating to said Partnership  
and that after making the said agreement  
& Partnership the said Plaintiff and Defendant  
proceeded to carry on said Partnership busi-  
ness for about the period of eight months  
and that during the time they so carried  
on said business the said Plaintiff and  
Defendant as such partners bought Shipped  
and sold in the City of Philadelphia and  
and elsewhere one hundred and thirty  
horses at an aggregate Cost of Horses  
and expenses of twenty two thousand Dollars  
That there was realized from the sales of said  
horses the sum of ~~twenty three~~<sup>one</sup> hundred ~~other~~  
after thousand Dollars after paying the  
salesman his Commission in the City  
of Philadelphia leaving at net profit  
to the said Plaintiff and Defendants as  
such partners of one thousand Dollars that  
in the carrying on of said Partnership busi-  
ness the said Plaintiff invested for the  
use of said firm in said business of his  
funds and money that he drew from the  
sales and his co-partners the sum of  
Eight thousand two hundred and sixty  
four Dollars and itemized as follows  
of which is filed herewith and that the  
Plaintiff drew from Sales and from Capital
