Your petitioner Franklin  
Smith of said County of Adams respectfully  
represents that your petitioner  
has a legal right to and is seized in  
fee simple as his separate property  
the undivided two thirds parts of a  
certain tract or parcels of land with  
the appurtenances thereto belonging  
lying and being in the County of Adams and  
State of Indiana and described as follows  
to wit The South West quarter of the North  
East quarter of section one (1) in Township  
twenty five (25) North of Range fourteen  
(14) East in said County of Adams and  
that he is also the owner of two third  
parts of a tax title for the following  
described land to wit the south East  
quarter of the North East quarter of section  
one (1) in township twenty five (25) North  
of Range fourteen East in said County  
of Adams

And your petitioner further re-  
presents that Elizabeth Hornshell Mar-  
tha Hornshell and the unknown  
heirs of Joseph Hornshell late of said

County deceased are tenants in com-  
mon with your petitioners in the said  
premises that the said Elizabeth is  
the widow of the said Joseph Forn-  
shell deceased and that Martha  
Fornshell is the daughter of said Joseph  
Fornshell deceased and that the said  
deceased has other children who are  
as unknown to your petitioners and  
who are necessary Defendants to this pro-  
cEDURE. And that the said Martha  
Fornshell is a minor. That the said  
Elizabeth Fornshell Martha Fornshell  
and the minor children of Joseph Forn-  
shell deceased are the heirs at law of  
the said Joseph Fornshell deceased.  
All of whom your petitioners pray may  
be made Defendants to this petition.

Your petitioners therefore desiring  
to hold his said interest in security  
pray that partition of said land may  
be made by the Court appointing three  
disinterested freeholders of the County  
of Adams who shall in accordance with  
the judgments of partition assign to your  
Petitioners two thirds in value of said land  
above described and assign and at will  
to the said Defendants jointly one third  
in value of said land or if it shall appear  
that partition cannot without manifest

injustice to do so that the same may be  
sold pursuant to the Statute in such cases  
made and provided and grant such other  
relief as is equitable, Franklin Smith
