and defendants are seized in fee simple as

inants in common of the following
described Real Estate to wit, the North
East quarter of section four (4) in Town-
ship twenty six (26) North of Range
thirteen (13) East & situated to contain
one hundred and seventy five acres and
forty nine hundredths of an acre in the
