defendant of a plea that he owes to the said Plaintiff the sum  
of Sixty six dollars Eighty Seven and a half  
Lawful money which he owes to and unjustly detains  
from him, For that whereas Nancy Blossom  
Deceased late of Adams County Pennsylvania  
did during her Lifetime Contract the follow  
ing Debt to wit

For Taking care and Boarding said  
Deceased Ten Months during her last  
Sickness in the year A.D. 1842 \$60.00

And after her decease for Money paid  
for Coffin to William Avery in 1843. \$5.00

Money paid J. D. Putnam for buying  
Cloths for said Deceased. 1.87 1/2

all of which was furnished by  
the said Plaintiff for the use and Benefit  
of the said Defendant - and afterwards  
to wit after the decease of said Nancy  
Blossom who died intestate John Flagg  
was by this Court appointed administrator  
of said Estate as the record will more  
fully show - And then and there became  
liable to pay said debts of said deceased  
But the said defendant wholly refuses to  
pay said debt or any part thereof, although  
often requested to do so and still does  
refuse to the damage of said Plaintiff  
fifty dollars therefore he owes \$2 By John  
Purvis his

To the Sheriff of the State of Indiana to the Sheriff of Adams County Greeting  
Whereas Benjamin B Winant recovered judgement  
on the 13th day of November 1843 in the  
Probate court of Adams County State of Indiana  
against John Flagg Administrator of the estate of  
Charles Blossom deceased for the sum of forty  
five dollars and cost of suit which said judg-  
ment still remains in full force unpaid  
unreversed and undisturbed upon which said judg-  
ment no process of execution ever issued out  
of said court and a whereas said plaintiff  
hath brought us for relief and to revive said  
judgement to have execution thereon you are there-  
fore hereby commanded to summon said  
John Flagg if he be found in your Bailiwick to  
be and ~~appear~~ <sup>appear</sup> before the Judge of the Adams  
Probate court on the first day of the next term  
of said court to be held at the court house in  
said county on the second Monday of August  
next and then and there to show cause if  
any he can why said judgement should not  
be revived and execution issued thereon to  
be made for said plaintiff his said judgement in full  
and cost and have you then and there this  
with witness Samuel L Perry Clerk and  
the seal of our said court this 31<sup>st</sup> day of ~~June~~ <sup>May</sup>  
1849
