 Vouchers in this behalf in vacation the said Clerk for examination
 and upon such examination the same were filed in said Clerk's
 office which said Account Current and Vouchers are in words
 and figures following to wit: (h l) And public notice having
 been given by a publication in the Adams County Democrat
 a weekly newspaper printed and published in said County that
 said Account Current would be presented to the Court
 at the May Term thereof for examination and settlement
 which said notice was published more than ten days before
 the first day of the present term of said Court which said notice to
 proof of Publication are in words and figures following
 to wit: (h l) And the Court after having carefully examined
 said Account Current and Vouchers Notices of Proof of Publication
 and all these papers find said Estate to be insolvent and the
 said Administrator is therefore ordered by said Court
 of Common Pleas to settle said Estate as insolvent.
 And it further appearing to the Court that there were a
 number of preferred claims heretofore allowed against
 said Estate. which said Preferred Claims yet remaining unpaid and
 as follows to wit in favor of A. T. & L. M. Nuttman for
 three dollars and eight cents three cents and in favor of W. W. Moore
 for twenty five dollars & seventy five cents and in favor of
 Andrew Ross for twenty dollars and one in favor of
 Corvendale and Clark for five dollars and that the
 said Administrator has paid into the hands of the Clerk
 of said Court the sum of fifty four dollars and fifty
 eight cents for the payment of said Preferred Claims and
 that there no money belonging to said Estate for the payment
 of the other claims or any part thereof and that said
 Account Current has been verified by oath and appears
 to be substantially correct, as evidenced by the Vouchers
 it is therefore adjudged by the Court that the said Administrator
 has completed his trust in this behalf according to law
 he is therefore discharged from all further accountability
 to this Court, and from all further liability on his bond
 and there being no surplus for a pro rata or other payment
 of the other claims not among surplus for distribution this
 matter is ordered to be left off the Docket.
