FINAL DECREE ALLOWING FINAL ACCOUNT
DESIGNATING DISTRIBUTEES AND DIRECTING DISTRIBUTION

This cause came on to be heard this 23rd day of April, 1982, upon the final account petition to settle and allow account and for authority to distribute estate filed by Gordon W. Bracker, Personal Representative of the estate of Bessie Bracker, deceased, which account and petition are in words and figures following, to-wit: (H. I.). And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises NOW FINDS:

1. Due notice of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said estate and the same are now properly before the court for final action thereon, which notice and proofs of mailing and publication are in the following words and figures, to-wit: (H. I.).

2. The matters and things stated in said account and petition are true and that said Personal Representative has accounted for all assets in this estate coming into his hands.


3. More than five months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to heirs and creditors of said decedent, which notice of appointment and proofs of mailing and publication are in the following words and figures, to-wit: (H. I.). All claims against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor her Personal Representative were employers of labor within the meaning of that

term as used in Indiana Employment Security Act; all inheritance tax due has been paid, and all adjusted gross income has been paid and said estate was not subject to Federal Estate Taxes.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. Said report and account of said Personal Representative are hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.
2. Said Personal Representative is hereby directed to distribute and pay over to Gordon W. Bracker the entire balance in said estate consisting of personal property, both chattel and intangible, in the amount of \$5,882.14 and cash in the amount of \$1,217.74.
3. Decedent owned no real estate at the time of her death.
4. Said Gordon W. Bracker, Personal Representative, is hereby directed to file herein his supplemental report of distribution and attach thereto receipts and vouchers showing that distribution and payment of the balance of the assets in his hands has been made pursuant to the terms of this order and that said Personal Representative has in all things carried out the provisions of this FINAL DECREE.
