Comes now the Administrator on this behalf and having more than ten days prior to the first day of the present term of this Court filed in the Clerk's of this Court his account current & accompanying vouchers which are in these words (hI) And the Court by affidavit and Copy of notice filed is satisfied that ten days notice has been given according to law that said account & vouchers would be presented for settlement and allowance which affidavits and Copy of notices are in these words (hI) And the Court after having carefully compared and examined said account and vouchers, do Order adjudge and decree that said account be finally settled and allowed And by which it appears that there is paid into Court the Sum of Six hundred and Ninety five dollars and Sixty one cents (\$695.61) for distribution among the heirs at law of said Estate And the said Administrator having completed his duties as to his said trust is discharged from all further duties as such Administrator, and from all further liability on his said bond in this behalf

And the Clerk of this Court is now here Ordered to give notice thirty days before the first day of the next term of this Court according to law, that said Surplus will be distributed on the first day of the next term of this Court, and this matter is Continued;

The Court then adjourned until to morrow morning 9 o'clock A.M. 1834
