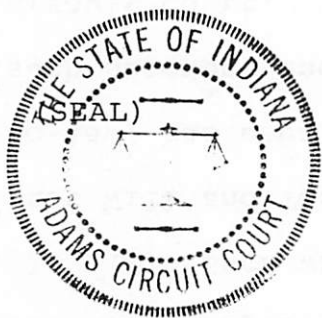
(3) Such Will, written testimony and Petition are in the following words and figures, to-wit: (H.I.)
