advised in the premises confirm said proceedings, and further order
the possession of the estate to be delivered over to the widow, without
any letters being granted, and without any further proceeding in
this behalf and that the clerk make out and deliver to her a
certificate of the property contained in said inventory upon the pay-
ment by her of the cost of this proceeding
