The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Samuel L Ruggs do truly and faithfully perform the duties and trusts committed to him as administrator of the Estate of Robert Daniels Sen, Deceased according to law, then the above obligation is to be void and of none effect otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in Law
