Comes now the Administrator in this behalf and files his petition to sell the Real Estate of Said decedent which petition is in these words (h) and files also a copy of the notice given and the proof of publication and posting the same which notice and the proof of publication and posting are in these words (h i) and files also the inventory and appraisement of said Real estate described in said petition which is in these words (h i) and files also his bond as such administrator which is approved by the Court and said defendants being each three times called comes not but herein wholly makes default and it being suggested to the Court that part of the heirs at law of said decedent are minors under the age of twenty one years the Court then appoints David Strickland Esq an attorney of this Court Guardian ad litem for said minors who now here accepts said appointment and files his answer to said petition which answer is in these words (i) And this case being ready for hearing upon petition answer of Guardian ad litem title papers &c. ^{the Court} find that the said decedent said seized of the Real Estate in said petition mentioned and that the same should be sold for the reasons therein set forth. — It is therefore ordered adjudge and determined by the Court that the Administrator proceed to sell the Real Estate described in said petition at public sale having first given notice in some public newspaper published in the County where the said lands is situated and by posting copies of said notice in five public places within the County three of which must be posted in the townships where said Real Estate is situated for four weeks before the day of sale on the following terms One third of the purchase money to be paid in hand one third in six and one third in twelve months from the day of sale by the purchaser giving his notes with approved security to the said Administrator. Said lands not to be sold for less than two thirds the appraised value.
