ORDER APPROVING RETENTION ON DOCKET



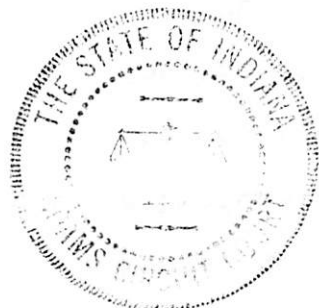
