And it appearing to the Court that no objections were filed thereto and the Court now being sufficiently advised in the premises now finds:

- 1. Due notice of the filing of said Account and Petition and of the hearing on the same was given to the heirs and beneficiaries of the decedent herein and all persons interested in his estate and said Account and Petition is now properly before the Court for action thereon.
- 2. The matters and facts set out and stated in said Account and Petition are true and the Personal Representative herein has duly accounted for all assets of said estate coming into its possession as such Personal Representative.
- 3. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to heirs and creditors herein, all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged, neither the decedent nor this Personal Representative were employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act.
