FINAL DECREE: (1) ALLOWING
FINAL ACCOUNT (2) DETERMINING
HEIRSHIP (3) AUTHORIZING
DISTRIBUTION

This cause came to be heard on this 19th day of May, 1982, upon the Final Account, Petition to Settle and Allow Final Account, Petition to Determine Heirship and Petition for Authority to Distribute Estate as filed by the Bank of Geneva, Personal Representative of the estate of Willis M. Dickason, deceased, which Account and Petition are in the following words and figures, to-wit: (H.I.)

And it appearing to the Court that no objections were filed thereto and the Court now being sufficiently advised in the premises now finds:

1. Due notice of the filing of said Account and Petition and of the hearing on the same was given to the heirs and beneficiaries of the decedent herein and all persons interested in his estate and said Account and Petition is now properly before the Court for action thereon.

2. The matters and facts set out and stated in said Account and Petition are true and the Personal Representative herein has duly accounted for all assets of said estate coming into its possession as such Personal Representative.

3. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to heirs and creditors herein, all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged, neither the decedent nor this Personal Representative were employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act. The inheritance tax due the State of Indiana with respect to this estate has been determined and fully paid as evidenced by the duly countersigned receipt of the Treasurer of Adams County, Indiana, attached to said Account. A federal estate tax return was filed by Personal Representative and no tax found to be due as evidenced by the estate tax closing letter attached to said account.

4. The decedent herein died testate and his Last Will and Testament was duly admitted to probate in this Court. That all provisions of the decedent's Last Will and Testament have been discharged except for the distribution of the surplus of the decedent's estate. By Item IV of the Decedent's Last Will and Testament provided for the disposition of the rest and residue of the Decedent's estate. By paragraphs (a) and (b) of this Item the Decedent bequeathed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) or one fourth (1/4) of the estate, whichever is lesser, to each of Virginia Bradshaw and Tomassina Lee. One fourth (1/4) of the Decedent's estate as shown by the account herein amounts to in excess of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) so that, Virginia Bradshaw and Tomassina Lee each will receive ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) as shown by the proposed distribution as shown on Exhibit "D" of the account.

Paragraphs (c) and (d) of Item IV dispose of the residue and remainder of the Decedent's estate, and left one equal share thereof to Mary Dickason and one equal share to his brother, Milo Dickason, or to his then living heirs if Milo Dickason should not survive the Decedent. Mary Dickason did in fact survive the Decedent and is entitled to share in this estate in accordance with the Decedent's Last Will and Testament. However, Mary Dickason has assigned one-third (1/3) of her share of the estate to each of her children, Janice A. Myers and Keith D. Dickason in accordance with the Assignment of Distributive Share attached to the account.

Milo Dickason did in fact predecease the Decedent herein and his heirs at law living at his death are his widow, Evelyn Dickason and his two daughters, Nancy Dickason Britt and Sue Dickason Booth, who are entitled to take and receive the share of the Decedent's estate bequeathed and devised by Item IV (d) of the Decedent's Last Will and Testament.

The Decedent herein died the record owner of two (2) parcels of real estate in the Town of Geneva, Adams County, Indiana, both of which were sold during the course of the administration of this estate and the proceeds included in the account herein.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT as follows:

1. Said Account, Petition and Report as heretofore filed herein by the Personal Representative of this estate is now and hereby in all things ratified, approved, settled and confirmed.

2. Said Personal Representative is hereby authorized and directed to distribute, pay over and transfer the balance of the personal property of said decedent remaining in its hands to Virginia Bradshaw, Tomassina Lee, Mary Dickason, Janice A. Myers, Keith D. Dickason, Evelyn Dickason, Nancy Dickason Britt and Sue Dickason Booth as proposed and set out in said account.

3. Said Personal Representative is hereby directed to file herein its supplemental report showing compliance with this Order and setting out that said Personal Representative has in all things carried out the provisions of this Final Decree.

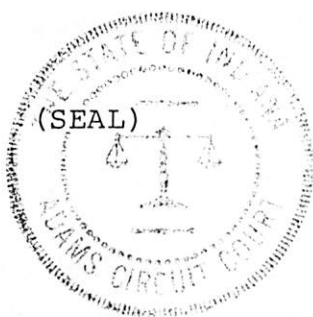
