Black Clerk of the Court pay the said Surplus to the said heirs follows to wit. that he pay to John Eley one seventh part of said Surplus to Catherine Black one seventh part of said Surplus & pay to Rodman Clark one seventh part of said Surplus and pay to Michael Eley one seventh part of said Surplus and pay to Samuel Eley one seventh part of said Surplus and that he pay to Elizabeth Hays one seventh part of said Surplus and that he pay to the heirs of George Eley deceased jointly one seventh part of said Surplus.
