Comes now the Clerk of this Court and
Clerk's Reports the presentation of the Account Current
and vouchers in this behalf in vacation to said Clerk
for examination the same were filed in said Clerk's
office when said account current and vouchers were
in words and figures following to wit (A D) said
public notice having been given by a publication in
the Adams County Democrat a weekly news paper
printed and published in said county that said account current
would be presented to the Court at the February Term
thereof for 1858. for examination and settlement.
Which said notice was published more than ten days
before the first day of the present term of said
Court when said notice and proof of publication
has been filed in the Clerk's office of said Court
when said notice and proof of publication are in
words and figures following to wit; (A D) said the
Court after having carefully examined said
account current and vouchers notice and
proof of publication find that said notice
has been given according to law and that said
account current has been verified correct
and appears to be substantially correct
as evidenced by the vouchers. It is therefore adjudged
by the Court that the said Administrator has completed
his trust in this behalf according to law he is
therefore discharged from all further accountability
to the Court, and from all further liability on his
bond. And as there is a surplus for distribution to wit the
