To the Honorable Abner Randall, Judge of the Probate Court of Adams County, in the State of Indiana. Absolam Roberts Administrator of the Estate of Phillip Everman deceased, respectfully reports that in pursuance of an order of this Honorable Court made at the last November term thereof, he the said Absolam Roberts, having given due notice of the time and place of sale, agreeably to the directions of said order, did on the 12th day of December last, expose to sale by public vendor the land therein mentioned, and sold the same to Henry Draga, for the sum of Five Hundred and fifty Eight Dollars, he being the highest bidder, and that the highest and best price bidden for the same.

law committed to him as the said Administrator, in
