And the Court after having carefully examined said
account current & vouchers find the same to correspond
And the Court further finds that the said Administrator
has completed his trust as such Administrator
according to law. It is therefore ordered that
said Administrator do settle and Report before said
Court and that said Administrator be discharged from
all further accountability to the Court on account
of said trust and from all further liability
on his Bond as such Administrator.

And as there is a surplus for distribution to wit
the sum of Three hundred & sixteen Dollars and four
cents which same is paid into the Clerk's Office into
the hands of the Clerk of the Court. On Motion of George
Frank Esq. it is ordered that said sum be distributed
among the heirs of said Joseph Frank deceased
and it appearing from evidence adduced in
open Court that Catharine Frank is the widow
of the said Joseph Frank deceased, and that John
Frank, Margaret Boyer, Mary Ann Frank,
Mariah Frank Nancy Frank and Maria
M. Frank and the children and the only
children of the said Joseph Frank deceased
and that all the said children and minors except
the said John Frank Margaret Boyer and
that the said Catharine Frank widow is a foreigner
has been appointed by the Court Guardian for
Mary Frank & Maria Frank and the Court
being fully advised in the premises do order and
determine that the Clerk of the Court pay the
said surplus to the said heirs of the said Joseph
Frank deceased as follows to wit. One third of
said surplus to the said Catharine Frank
widow as aforesaid for her life and the said
sixth part of the Remainder to John Frank and one
