DISTRIBUTION AFTER FIVE (5) MONTHS

Comes now Gloria M. Hakes, Kermit E. Garner and Dixie E. Hurst, as co-executors of the estate of Joseph E. Garner, deceased, and being duly sworn upon their oaths respectfully show the Court as follows:

1. That your petitioners are the duly qualified and acting co-executors of the estate of Joseph K. Garner.

2. That the first publication of notice of the opening of this estate was duly made on the 12th day of September, 1981, and therefor the time for filing of claims in said estate is now expired.

3. That the estate is solvent and your co-executors desire to make a partial distribution of the assets during the period of administration, which period of administration will be prolonged by reason of State Inheritance Tax determination.

4. That the balance of assets available for distribution in said estate is the sum of Twenty-eight Thousand Six Hundred Thirty Three and 69/100 Dollars (\$28,633.69) and petitioners ask for authority to distribute Twenty-four Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$24,000.00).

Comes now Gloria M. Hakes, Kermit E. Garner and Dixie E. Hurst as co-executors of the estate of Joseph K. Garner, deceased, and submit their verified Petition for Partial Distribution After Five (5) Months, which petition is in the words and figures following, to-wit:


And the Court having heretofore examined said petition and being fully advised in the premises now finds that the estate of the decedent is solvent, and that more than five (5) months have elapsed since the estate was duly opened, that the estate cannot be promptly closed for the reason that State Inheritance Tax determination is being made, and that after making partial distribution herein sought to be made, ample funds will remain in the estate to fully pay all additional debts, expenses, claims and costs of administration of said estate, that a partial distribution is in the best interests of the estate and of the distributees, and that the following persons are distributees of the estate of Joseph K. Garner and entitled to the following: Gloria M. Hakes - Eight Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$8,000.00), Kermit E. Garner - Eight Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$8,000.00), and Dixie E. Hurst - Eight Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$8,000.00), and that the prayer of said petition should be granted.
