And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto, and the Court being fully advised in the premises, NOW FINDS:

1. Due notice of the filing of said account and petition of the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said estate and the same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.
2. The matters and things stated in said account and petition are true and that said Co-Administrators have accounted for all of the assets in his estate coming into their hands.
3.
