Coming now the clerk of the Court
and produce the Account Current in the behalf
which said Account was finally settled & allowed
at the January term of the Court for 1862, by which it
was found that the said Administrators of said Estate had
deposited in the clerks office of said Court, in the hands of the
clerk thereof the sum of fifty five Dollars & forty seven
cents for distribution and the Court then and there ordered
the clerk of said Court to give the requisite notice that at the
next term of said Court the said surplus would be distributed
according to law, which said notice has been given by said
clerk by a publication in the Adams County Democrat a
weekly news paper published in said County for three weeks in
succession at least thirty days prior to the first day of the present

Benjamin Hersey, Sarah Dodge wife are the children and the only children of the said Adriel Hersey deceased, who are living, and that John Wilman Kelly is the grand child of said Adriel Hersey deceased, that the said John Wilman Kelly is the son and the only child of Laura Ann Kelly deceased, who was the daughter of the said Adriel Hersey deceased and that the unknown heirs of Anna Hersey are also the grand children of the said Adriel Hersey deceased. It is therefore ordered Adjudged & determined by the Court that the said James B. Vinickes pay & distribute the said surplus to the said heirs or to their Executors or assigns to wit that he pay to the said Benjamin Hersey the one fifth part of said surplus to wit eleven dollars & nine cents for his share of said surplus and to Sarah Dodge the sum of five eleven dollars & nine cents, and to John Wilman Kelly the said Father of said John Wilman Kelly, the said John Wilman Kelly being a minor and having no Guardian but the said Father having the care of said child. It is ordered that said eleven dollars & nine cents be paid to the said John B. Kelly for the use of said minor, and that the said Vinickes pay the remaining sum of eleven dollars & nine cents to the heirs of Anna Hersey. And that the said Clerk take vouchers from the said heirs for the amounts so ordered to be paid as of and for the Court, and determined by the Court, all of which is ordered as aforesaid.
