4. That such will, written testimony and petitions read as follows: (H.I.)


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that:

1. Such written instrument purporting to be the Last Will and Testament of such decedent be and it is hereby admitted to probate and recorded as such.

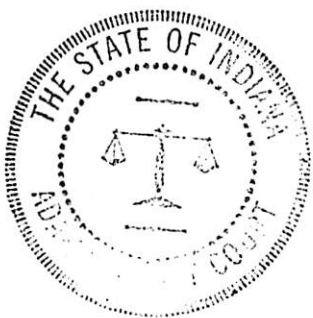
2. That Mary Maxine Dull is appointed as Executrix of the estate of Esther L. Hilton.
