Comes now, James A. Holthouse, and being first duly sworn would show to the Court as follows: James A. Holthouse (SEAL)

1. That this affiant is the duly appointed, and acting administrator of the estate of Arthur R. Holthouse, deceased, who died intestate on the 28th day of October, 1954.
2. That on the 17th day of February, 1955 this administrator filed an Inventory with this court, and on the same date this court did examine and approve said Inventory.
3. That among the assets of the estate shown in said Inventory filed on February 17, 1955 were 150 shares of Common Stock in the Decatur Democrat Company, which in said Inventory was valued at Three Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$375.00) per share, making a total value shown in said Inventory for said stock the sum of \$56,250.00.
4. That said value of \$375.00 per share for said Decatur Democrat Company stock was at that time the value which this administrator thought was the fair cash value of said stock; however, this administrator has since learned and been advised by the officers of said corporation that said value would only be a fair value for a majority, or controlling interest in said corporation, and not a fair value for shares constituting a minority interest in said corporation.
5. That said 150 shares of stock, represents only a minority interest in said corporation, inasmuch as there is 500 shares of stock outstanding in said corporation.

6. That this administrator has been advised by the officers of said corporation that the fair cash value for a minority interest in said corporation would not be \$375.00 per share, but would instead be \$250.00 per share, or a total of \$37,500.00 for 150 shares.

7. That this administrator is filing this Amended Inventory to reflect the true fair cash value of said Decatur Democrat Company
