1st That the personal Property which has come to
his hands belonging to said Estate amounts to the
sum of sixty dollars and twenty five cents,
2nd All of which has been delivered by said Administrator
to Mary Miller late Mary Kniskern and lately the
widow of said Dec'd in part payment of her
Dower in the Estate of her said Deceased husband
as shown by her receipt annexed to the inventory
of said Estate both of which are on the files of
this Court

3rd The Debts outstanding against said Estate so
far as the same can be ascertained amount to
the sum of One hundred and seventeen dollars
except the Costs of Administration, And that
the personal Estate is insufficient to pay
the same

4th The real Estate which the said Deceased had
at the time of his Death subject to be made assets
for the payment of his Debts was the equal
