And the Court after having carefully examined said
account found it correct and the Court allowed the sum of four
hundred and thirty eight dollars and eighty three
cents for his services as executor and the Court
finds by said Report that there is in his hands

to go to his successor notes to the amount of two hundred and fifty two dollars and fifty two cents & cash to the amount of sixty three dollars and sixty four cents. And thereupon the said Decree filed in Court his Resignation of said Trust in these words (h. s.) which is accepted by the Court, and he is ordered to pay over to his successor the notes and amount paid to be in his hands as above stated which is now here done and he is discharged from all further accountability to the Court and from all further liability on his bonds. And Jesse Noble is by the Court appointed Administrator de bonis non with the will annexed of said Estate and now he gives bond as such in the penalty of Three Thousand Dollars and letters issued to him accordingly. And on motion the matter is continued.
