Comer now the Clerk of this Court and produces the account Current in the behalf, which said account was finally settled and allowed at the last term of this Court, by which it was found that the said Administrator of said Estate had deposited in the Clerk's office of said Court in the hands of the Clerk thereof the sum fifty seven dollars and thirteen cents for distributions and the Court then and there ordered the Clerk of said Court to give the requisite notice that at the next term of said Court the said surplus would be distributed accordingly to law. which said notice has been given by said Clerk by a publication in the Adams County Democrat, a weekly newspaper published in said County for three weeks in succession at least thirty days prior to the first day of the present term of this Court, which said notice is in words and figures following to wit: (H.S.) to which said notice is attached the Proof of publication in words and figures following to wit: (H.S.) and by posting like notices in five public places in said County. a copy of which notice is produced & filed in the Clerk's office to which said notice is attached the Proof of posting up said notices which said proof is in words and figures following to wit: (H.S.) whereupon the Court find that legal notice has been given in this behalf at least thirty days before the first day of the present term of this Court by publication in the Adams County Democrat a weekly newspaper published in said County and by notices posted up in five public places in said County and it appearing from the evidence of a competent witness

That Sophia Reicheloffen is the widow of said Charles Reicheloffen deceased and as such widow is entitled to one third of said surplus and it appearing from a certified copy of the letters of Guardianship granted to Edward W. Reed of Adams County and that of children Reicheloffen & Charles Reicheloffen the minor children of Charles Reicheloffen deceased when said certified copy of Guardianship is in words and figures following to wit (N.B.) 13y which it appears to the Court that the said Edward W. Reed is the Guardian of the said William Reicheloffen & Charles Reicheloffen the said heirs of the said Charles Reicheloffen deceased And it being made known to the Court by the Clerk thereof that there remains unpaid the costs of distribution the sum of Fifty Dollars and cents which the Clerk is ordered to pay out of said surplus And the Court being fully advised in the premises finds that the sum of fifty two dollars and thirteen cents after deducting the costs above ordered to be paid remains for distribution And the Court being fully advised in the premises so ordered and Judge now determines that the Clerk of this Court pay the said surplus to the said widow and Guardian of said children as follows to wit that he pay one third of said surplus to the said widow for her share thereof and that he pay to the said Guardian of said minor children the other two thirds of said surplus for their share thereof. to wit That he pay Sophia Reicheloffen the sum of seventeen Dollars & thirty eight cents in full for her share of said surplus and that he pay Edward W. Reed the Guardian of said Minors as aforesaid the sum of thirty four Dollars and seventy six cents in full for the share of said widow of the said surplus of said estate and the Clerk is ordered to take the receipt of said Sophia Reicheloffen and the receipt of the said Guardian for the said sums upon the pay ment thereof all of which is ordered and judges & determined by the Court. Received of James B. Brincker the Clerk of the Court of common Pleas the sum of seventeen Dollars & thirty eight cents in full of my intestate share of the surplus of my deceased husband's estate this the 28th day of August 1860 Sophia Reicheloffen by E. W. Reed Received of James B.
