the Honorable Judge of the Court of Common
Plea that he Received of the said Margaretta
the Sum of One hundred and ninety one Dollars
as trust for the said Margaretta Peffer and that
by the Provisions of the will of Elizabeth McMan
the Son the interest of said Money was ordered to
be paid to the said Margaretta Peffer each and
every year during her lifetime and that the Principal
to be paid to her children. And a further Report that
I have paid to the said Margaretta Peffer the full amount of
the Interest of the said Sum of One hundred and
ninety one Dollars as per Receipt No. 1. \$ 63.73 and
I have paid the Clerk of Court of Wayne County in the State
of Ohio Five Dollars Eighty seven cents out of the
Principal. \$ 58.75

I have paid David Thaddeus Two Dollars for Attorney fees 2.00
I have paid Long Brothers back Three Dollars & 75 cents 3.75
as per Receipt No. 2.
I have paid Long Brothers back Seven Dollars &
Seventy five cents as per Receipt No. 3 7.75
The Trustee Charges for paper & services in attending to
said Trust at 75 cts per day 310
Amount of Principal expended \$ 27.13

leaving a balance of the principal in my hands to the amount of one
hundred & thirty eight Dollars & eighty seven cents \$ 168.87
And as there is much cash & expended attending the Motherly
having the said cash to be paid in the Court of Common
Plea the year and as the Trust will not expire until
the decision of the said Margaretta Peffer the undersigned
would humbly ask Your Honor to cause the
said Matter to be left in the Court until the death of
the said Margaretta Peffer
