It is thereupon Ordered Adjudged and Determined by the Court that all the property of said decedent both Real & personal be delivered over to his widow Jane D. Spencer, discharged from all debts of the said decedent except Mortgages on Real Estate the expence of his last sickness and funeral and costs of the proceeding, And that the Clerk of the Court, give to his said widow Jane D. Spencer a certificate to that effect. It is thenupon Ordered that no letters of Administration shall issue on said Estate and the matter is to be left off the docket, All of which is Ordered Adjudged & determined by the Court.
