 Settlement Report had been given by a
 Publication in a public newspaper required
 by law the Court finds that said Official
 Settlement Report ought to be confirmed.
 It is therefore considered & Adjudged by the
 Court that the said Administrator has
 completed his trust as such Administrator
 according to law he is therefore discharged
 from all further accountability to the
 Court on account of said Administrator's estate
 and from all further liability on his bond
 as such Administrator. And there is
 no surplus for distribution among
 the heirs of said decedent the matter
 is left to the Court. All of which
 is ordered & Adjudged and determined by
 the Court.
