Comes now Margaret Biberstein, and would respectfully
make herein her current report in the above entitled matter:--

1. That she is the duly appointed and acting and
qualified Guardian of said Claude Biberstein, and that she
was appointed as such Guardian by this Court on the 15th day
of December 1952;

2. That there after, on the 17th day of April, 1953, she
filed her current report showing receipts and disbursements
from date to appointment to said date of report, and showing a
deficit of \$ 3.69, which said report was duly approved by this
Court and said guardianship continued.

3. That since said date of April 17, 1953 to December 4,
1953, she continued to receive insurance compensation checks from
Dunbar Manufacturing Company in the sum of \$37.50 per week; that
on said December 4, 1953 she received her final check in full of
payments of such insurance benefits; that the total amount
received since said last current report amounted to the sum
of \$1,237.50.

4. That since said date of last current report, she has made
the following expenditures, towit:--

6. This undersigned Guardian would further show to the Court that she is the wife of her said ward, Claude Biberstein. That the expenses above set out as and for her home, were necessary for her maintenance and that of their children, Sharon, age 17 years, and Judy, age 11 years, all of whom are minors and the children of her said ward.

7. That this undersigned Guardian would further show to the Court that said Claude Biberstein is presently at the Easthaven Richmond State Hospital, Richmond, Indiana, but that she resides in Geneva, Adams County, Indiana with her said children.

WHEREFORE, this undersigned Guardian prays the Court that her report herein be approved, and that this guardianship be continued pending the illness of her ward, Claude Biberstein.

That Comes now Margaret Biberstein, Guardian by appointment of this Court and would respectfully make herein her current report in the above entitled matter:--

1. That heretofore on the 19th day of April, 1954, she filed her report 'current' in the above entitled matter showing a deficit of \$206.08 which this undersigned guardian had made up from her own personal funds and from wages received from her own employment. That since said date, she has paid from her own funds, the Spring Installment of taxes to the Treasurer of Adams County, Indiana; and she has also paid installment payments on a roof repair contract on her dwelling and also kept up the monthly payments on the mortgage on her property and that of her ward, all from her own funds, and in addition to which she has maintained and supported her two minor children.

2. That from the sale of her wards real estate and as shown in her report of said sale heretofore filed on the 25th day of June, 1954, she received the sum of \$3,000.00 for which she charges herself.

3. That since said date of sale, she has made the following expenditures and payments, all in the interest of her ward:--
