 praying for the sale of the said

 Guardian is sound with sufficient
 surety in the State and County where
 said appointment was made and
 thereupon the Court appointed David H. Davidson
 Esq as Guardian ad litem for said Orphan
 person who accepts said appointment
 and files his answer as such Guardian
 ad litem in these words (h d) and
 on motion the matter is set down
 for hearing upon petition answered and
 ad litem the papers documentary and

Said insane person is the owner in fee simple of the following described lands situated in the County of Adams and State of Indiana to wit: Fifty three acres and fifty hundredths of an acre off of the West side of the South West quarter of section thirty-two township twenty six North of Range fourteen East. and that the said court be sold for the purposes set forth in said Petition and the Court being fully advised in the premises do order and Judge and determine that said lands ought to be sold and thereupon the Court appoint John McFarland and George Frank two free holders of the County as appraisers to appraise the lands above described as the property of said insane person And that the Clerk of the Court is hereby Ordered to issue a certificate of appointment to said Appraisers in due form of law requesting them to appraise the said land and Report their appraisement on or before the first day of the next Term of the Court. and the matter is continued.
