- 1. That heretofore on the 5th day of March, 1971, he was appointed as legal guardian of Louise C. Bultemeier, an Incompetent and a resident of Adams County, Indiana, having been transferred there from the Richmond State Hospital.
- 2. That the purpose of said Guardianship was to receive monthly checks from the Adams County Department of Public Welfare, having made application therefore, and upon receiving the same to endorse said said monthly allowances and forward the same to the Adams County Home.
- 3. That he did, thereafter and heretofore, on the 10th day of April, 1980, submit to the Court his Guardian's Current Report, showing that said guardianship fund was in full force and effect, and said guardianship was continued.
- 4. That the duties and responsibilities of said Guardianship have enlarged to the extent of making periodic reports to the Social Security Administration and also to the Adams County Department of Public Welfare, by reason of the numerous changes instituted under the laws of the United States of America and by his requirements to visit his ward on numerous occasions and report to the various agencies.
- 5. That since last accounting, he has received a total sum of \$2,708.40. That said exact and complete accounting of all accounts received is shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.
- 6. That since said last accounting, he has paid out in expenses for the use and benefit of his said ward, and for the Guardian's and Attorney's services, the sum of \$2,560.16, as shown on Exhibit "B" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

7. That a recapitulation of the receipts and credits, leaves a balance, as of April 10, 1982 of \$1,612.20 as shown on Exhibit "C" attached hereto and by reference, made a part hereof.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned Guardian prays that this report may be approved and an allowance for his servises may be approved and for all other relief right and proper in the premises, and this Guardianship be continued.


