Goss.) Guardianship of Mary Goss, Guardian in this behalf respectfully Reports to the Court that said wards are the owners of two undivided thirds parts of the half of the quarter of section in Township twenty seven North of Range Number fourteen (14) East about fifty three acres & 66 hundredths of an acre which said land they have acquired by inheritance from their father the rents of which since the death of said Father of said minors have amounted to the amount of about \$67.00 I am also charged with the amount of money received from Joseph Shouler the Administrator of the Estate of Peter J. Goss deed the sum of \$201.71 and interest up to the date on the same \$6.00 I claim credit for amount paid S. C.
