Comes now Elizabeth J. Yoder and being first duly sworn upon her oath respectfully petitions the Court as follows:

1. That the undersigned was appointed as Guardian for the person and estate of Salome Graber by previous order entered by this Court on the 26th day of February, 1982 .

2. That since said time, the undersigned has acted as Guardian over the person and estate of Salome Graber and has been providing for her care and keep and rendering personal services in so doing.

3. That since the prior order of this Court, the Doctor of the Ward herein has advised the undersigned that the Ward is in need on continuous care and that she must be attended 24 hours per day and that said Ward cannot be left to care for herself at any time.


4. The undersigned has investigated various nursing homes to provide continuous care for the Ward and has determined that it would cost in excess of one thousand six hundred dollars (\$1,600.00) per month for continous nursing home care and that the undersigned is able and willing to provide continuous care for said Ward by the undersigned and various members of her family staying with said Ward or in the alternative taking said Ward into the home of the undersigned and caring for her continuously there.

5. That the undersigned believes that the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) per week would be a reasonable fee for her services rendered in providing this continuous care for said Ward resulting in a substantial savings for the Ward as opposed to care in a nursing home facility at this time.

6. That it may be necessary from time to time to hire such additional persons as may be necessary to care for said Ward when it is necessary for the undersinged to be out of town for short periods of time and that the undersigned be authorized and directed


to expend a reasonable sum out of the Ward's funds to pay for such services on an hourly basis as may be necessary to care for said Ward.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned prays that the Court enter an order authorizing and directing her to pay out of the Ward's funds to the undersigned the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) per week for the continuous care and keep of said Ward; that she be authorized and directed to hire such additional help as may be necessary on an hourly basis to care for said Ward in her absence; and finally for such further orders as may be right and proper in the premises.

IT IS NOW THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY THE COURT that the Guardian herein, Elizabeth J. Yoder, be authorized to pay to herself the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) per week for the continuous care of said Ward as prayed in her Petition and that she be further ordered to employ such part-time help on an hourly basis as may be necessary to care for said Ward in her absence and that said sum shall be paid out of the assets of said Ward, all until further order of the Court.
