GUARDIAN'S SEMI-ANNUAL REPORT

This undersigned Affiant would respectfully show to the Court as follows, to-wit:

1. That heretofore on the 22nd day of October, 1971, he was appointed as legal guardian of Dale C. Miller, an Incompetent and a resident of Adams County Home, having been transferred there from the Richmond State Hospital.

2. That the original purpose of said Guardianship was to receive monthly checks from the Adams County Department of Public Welfare, having made application therefore, and endorse said checks and allowances and forward the same to the Adams County Home. However, due to changes in Federal Laws, pertaining to the Adams County Department of Public Welfare, it came necessary for him to make numerous periodic visits to the Adams County Home, and check on the welfare of his ward, Dale C. Miller. That in addition thereto, he had to make periodic reports to the Federal Government Health, Education and Welfare Departments, and also periodic reports in writing to the Adams County Department of Public Welfare. That it further became necessary, upon receipt of check from the Auditor's Office of the State of Indiana to make deposits and issue checks as requested by the Adams County Home directly to the Guardian or for the benefit of the Guardian, all as shown on the Exhibits attached hereto.

3. That the Guardian has deposited all receipts as required by the various regulations and institutions of the United States Government in the State of Indiana, and he attaches hereto as Exhibit "A" an accounting of his receipts hereof.


4. That said Guardian has paid all expenses as required, as shown on Exhibit "B" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That after all expenses have been paid and allowances for

the Guardian and Attorney herein, there remains in his hands in the checking account at The First State Bank of Decatur, Indiana, the sum of \$549.54, all as shown on Exhibit "C" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned Guardian prays that this report may be approved and an allowance for his servises may be approved and for all other relief right and proper in the premises, and this Guardianship be continued.



ORDER ON GUARDIAN'S REPORT

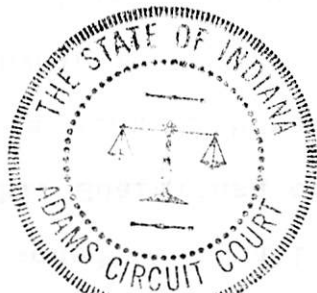
