of Christa Stogdile a Minor.

Inventory - A Just True and perfect inventory

which has come to the hands or knowledge
of William Diehe his Guardian, First - about
nine acres of land in French Township
worth about one hundred dollars part of which
is cleared, which is used and occupied by
said minor and his Mother the vent of which
is worth about \$5.00^{cts}, Second - I Received of
the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas of
said County, \$11.75^{cts}

Third - There was sixty dollars in the hands
of the mother of said ward which has been
paid out for land for the said Ward which
last named Sixty Dollars never came to my
hands but was appropriated for the purchase
of a small tract of land adjoining his other
tract supposed to be nearly nine acres in
the said Township of French which last
named tract of land is supposed to be
worth about \$100.00^{cts}
