Item 1. I will and bequeath my checking account in the First State Bank of Decatur to Lillian Tope, to be held in trust and used for the payment of premiums on Western and Southern Life Insurance Policies on Ernest Richard Tope Dye, Mary Elizabeth Dye and Dwight Dye, Jr. Provided that any balance remaining in said checking account after the said policies are paid in full, shall be divided share and share alike amongst said three named children.

Item 2. All the residue of my personal estate, I bequeath and devise to Lillian Tope.

Item 3. I constitute and appoint Lillian Tope, Executrix of this will, and Hubert R. McClenahan, attorney for my estate.
