Last Will and Testament of Andrew Appelman.
I, Andrew Appelman of Washington Township in Adams
County in the State of Indiana do hereby make and
publish and Declare the following to be my last will and
Testament hereby Revoking all former Wills Ever by me
made or expressed.

Item first; It is my will and I hereby direct that
all my just debts and the Expenses of my last sickness, and
my funeral Expenses be first paid out of my Estate.

Item second. After the above Items Complied with,
then I give and bequeath all of my Ertly Holdings, both
Real Estate and personal property of all kind and Description
also including accounts and credits of all kind and description
to my beloved wife Anne M Appelman to have and to
hold in fee simple absolute as her own and for her use,
and to ^{her} heirs and assigns forever and I further will that
no Executor be appointed in and for my Estate, but that
my Will shall be my said wife's power to act and
adjust all my Ertly affairs the same as I could do
if Living.
