 I, the undersigned, James M. Archbald of Davis County, Indiana, being of sound mind and of legal age,  
 in due and lawful manner, make, publish and declare the following to be  
 my last will and testament, fully knowing my acts are free by  
 me herefore made, to wit:

Item first: It is my will that all my just debts and funeral expenses  
 shall be paid as soon after my death as they can conveniently be paid  
 without injury to my estate.

I will devise and bequeath to my beloved wife  
 Mary C. Archbald, for and during her natural life all the property  
 both real and personal that I may own at the time of my death.

Item 2nd: At the death of my said wife Mary C. Archbald, it  
 is my will and I hereby give, bequeath and devise to my children  
 Estelle Marie, Addie E. Schwarz and Jennie G. Archbald, share and  
 share alike, all the residue of my property, both real and personal,  
 except and provided that as much as I have heretofore made  
 some advancements to my said children Estelle Marie and Addie E.  
 Schwarz, it is my desire and I hereby give and bequeath to  
 my said child Jennie G. Archbald such an amount, either

in money or personal property as may be necessary to make  
 my said child Jennie G. Archbald equal with my other  
 children. Said money or personal property to be paid or delivered  
 to said Jennie G. Archbald, at any time after my death and  
 during the life of my said wife Mary C. Archbald or at the death  
 of my said wife, as she, my said wife may desire.

Item fourth - I do hereby nominate and appoint my beloved  
 wife Mary C. Archbald as executrix of this my last will and  
 testament. In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand
