Last Will of Susannah Archer

In the name of the Benevolent Father of all;
 I Susannah Archer a resident of Adams County, Indiana
 and being of sound mind and memory, do make, publish
 and declare this to be my last will and testament hereby
 revoking all former wills by me made.

Item One. It is my will that all my just debts and
 funeral expenses shall be first paid, and that my executor
 herein after named, shall erect a suitable monument at my
 grave.

Item Two. I give, devise and bequeath all all my
 property both real and personal to the following named children
 and grand children and in the share herein named.

To my son John Archer the one ninth part thereof.

To my son Columbus Archer the one ninth part thereof.

To my son David Archer the one ninth part thereof.

To my son Jerry Archer the one ninth part thereof.

To my daughter Deahille Winans the one ninth part thereof.

To my son Amanda Masts the one ninth part thereof.

To my son Elmer Archer the one ninth part thereof.

To my grand children Jesse Faust, Elton Faust and Corles
 Faust together the one ninth part thereof.

To my grand children Benjamin Winans, Herbert
 Winans, Charles Winans, Frank Winans, Kenneth Winans
 and Mabel Winans together the one ninth part thereof.

It is understood by this item that my grand
 children Jesse Faust, Elton Faust and Corles Faust shall
 together take an equal share with one of my children, they
 bring the children of my daughter Eviline Faust deceased,
 and that my grand children Benjamin Winans, Herbert
 Winans, Charles Winans, Frank Winans, Kenneth

 equal part with one of my children, they bring the
