I, Henry A. Aschleman, residing at Berne Rural Route, County of Adams, State of Indiana, and being of sound and disposing mind and memory and not acting under duress, menace, fraud, or undue influence of any person whatsoever, do make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament:

ITEM ONE

It is my will and I hereby direct my executor hereinafter named, to pay all my just debts and funeral expenses as soon after my demise as can be lawfully and conveniently done.

ITEM TWO

After the payment as in Item One of this will provided, then it is my will and I hereby give, devise and bequeath to my beloved wife, Daisy M. Aschleman, all the rest and residue of my estate, both real and personal, she to have undisputed right of title and possession thereof as long as she remains my widow, except that it is further my will that, as our two daughters, Rose Marie and Phyllis Jean, reach the age of 21 years, and I should have passed on previously to their attaining their legal age, they be given the sum of one thousand dollars each upon such attainment.

ITEM THREE

In the event of the termination of my said wife's widowhood by marriage, then it is my will and I desire that my remaining property, both real and personal, be divided among my heirs as provided for by the Statutes of the sovereign State of Indiana.

ITEM FOUR

I hereby nominate and designate my Beloved wife, Daisy M. Aschleman, as the executor of this my last will and testament.
