1st. That my wish and desire that my beloved wife Barbara Augsburger shall have all my property, say the whole estate left of my real and personal property, all my debts, 2d. That further my wish and desire that my beloved wife Barbara Augsburger shall have all my property, say two Sums Money Augsburger and John C. Augsburger in business affairs.

3d. That further my wish and desire that if any one of my heirs should appear to court to make this will null and void the expenses shall be paid out of it as soon as.

4th. That further my wish and desire that after my beloved wife's decease that the remainder of my estate shall be divided into equal shares to my twelve children named, Charlotte Hoffmann, Mary C. Augsburger, Ann Augsburger, Jacob C. D. Augsburger, Sarah Augsburger, Ephraim Augsburger, John C. Augsburger, Elizabeth Augsburger, David Augsburger.
