LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

of

NOAH AUGSBURGER

I, Noah Augsburg, residing at Geneva, Adams County, Indiana, make and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament hereby enumerating and publishing the following Articles Testamentary:

ARTICLE I

I hereby revoke all wills and codicils thereto, heretofore executed by me.

ARTICLE II

It is my will that all my just debts be paid by my Executor, hereinafter named, from any funds available, but using personal assets, if possible, for that purpose.

ARTICLE III

I direct my Executor to pay the cost of my last illness, funeral expenses, and the cost of the administration of my estate.

ARTICLE IV

I give and bequeath to my wife, Jennie Augsburg, all of the household goods and appliances in the home where we now reside.

ARTICLE V

I will, give and devise a life estate in real estate described as follows:

Inlot Number Two Hundred Sixty-eight (268) in the Town of Geneva, Indiana, as designated on Studabaker's Recorded Plat of his Addition to said town, except therefrom 4 feet of even width off of the east side of said Inlot Number Two Hundred Sixty-eight (268),

to my wife, Jennie Augsburg.

ARTICLE VI

Should my wife, Jennie Augsburg, desire not to avail herself of the life estate as granted in the preceding Article V, then in lieu thereof, I will, give and bequeath to her the sum of \$1,000.00.

All the rest and residue of my estate I will, give, bequeath and devise to my children aforesaid, share and share alike.

ARTICLE IX.

I nominate, constitute and appoint my son, Palmer M. Augsburg, Executor of this my Last Will and Testament.
