LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

I, Henry Aumann, of R. R. 1, Decatur, Adams County, Indiana, being of sound mind and disposing memory, declare and publish this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby enumerating and publishing the following Articles Testamentary:

ARTICLE I.

I hereby revoke all former wills and codicils thereto heretofore executed by me.

ARTICLE II.

I direct my Executor hereinafter named, to pay all of my just debts, expenses of my last illness and burial and the costs of the administration of my estate as soon after my death as can reasonably be done.

ARTICLE III.

After payment of all charges heretofore laid out I will, give, bequeath and devise the rest and residue of my estate to my three children: Loretta Allmandinger, my daughter; Norbert Aumann, my son; and Elinor Graves, my daughter, and all are to share and share alike.

ARTICLE IV.

I nominate, constitute and appoint my son, Norbert Aumann, as Executor of my Last Will and Testament. It is my will that my Executor serve in such capacity without the necessity of posting a surety bond if the Court of proper jurisdiction of my estate shall approve.

ARTICLE V.

It is my will that my Executor receive a fair and reasonable amount to reimburse him for his expenses incurred in acting as Executor of this My Last Will and Testament.
