I Abraham Baughman of Adams County in the State of Indiana do make and publish this my last Will and testament hereby revoking and making void all former Wills by me at any time heretofore made First I direct that my Body be decently interred and that my funeral be conducted in a manner corresponding with my estate and situation in life And as to such worldly estate as it has pleased God to entrust me with I dispose of the same in the following manner to wit I direct first that all my just Debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon after my decease as possible out of the first moneys that shall come into the hands of my Executors from any portion of my property or estate either real or personal I next direct that all my household furniture personal property and real estate which I shall die seized on possessed shall be and remain the absolute property of my beloved wife Sarah Baughman if she shall be living at the time of my decease And I hereby Make and ordain my worthy and esteemed friend George Lurkey, Executor of this my last Will and testament In witness whereof I Abraham Baughman the testator have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourteenth day of May in the
