Will of Peter Bettz 100

June 18th 1864 Know all men that my last will and testament is as follows.

I give to my wife Elizabeth Bettz all my land and property which I now own and that is to be paid of property. Except my double barrel Rifle that I give to my son Francis Benjamin and at the death of my wife I give it to my son and my wife or son is to pay each of my daughters forty dollars out of my land or property as soon as they become able or when my son becomes of age and I want David D. Bevelhimer to Administer on my property to see that is right divided as set forth above signed by his Request Peter Bettz
