1858 Will of Jacob Blouvelt

I Jacob Blouvelt of Adams County and State of Indiana do make and publish my last will and testament hereby reaching and making void all former wills by me at any time hereto made save I direct that my body be deemed by intestate and that my funeral be conducted in a manner conforming with my testator and siting in life and as to such work by estate as it has pleased God to kindness me with, I dispose of the same in the following manner to wit I direct first that all my debts and several Expenses be paid as soon after my decease as possible of the first money that shall come to the hands of my Executor Real or personal I also direct that my beloved wife be my whole sole Executor of my will and testament In witness whereof I Jacob Blouvelt the testator have hereunto set my hand and seal this 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1856 Jacob Blouvelt Signed Sealed published and declared by the above named Jacob Blouvelt as his last will & testament in the presence of our
